COLLEGE PLANNING

With thousands of universities and colleges in the United States, how can parents choose the best one for their children? Parents engage in interactive activities as we discuss the role parents have in the college readiness process. We define what exactly college readiness is, the importance of the ACT/SAT exams, and the common college admission requirements. Parents become familiar with college tours, the college transition process, and the college culture.



CAREER EXPLORATION

One of the most important decisions our children will make in life is choosing a future career. Parents become familiar with different types of resources to help their children decide on choosing the right career. We review post-secondary admission requirements for undergraduate and graduate programs such as architecture, law school, medical school, and other types of specialty programs to help them plan in advance for their future careers.



FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

College is expensive! The good news is that there is plenty of free money out there to cover those college expenses. During this session, parents learn how to access financial resources to cover their children's college education. We discuss the different types of financial assistance such FAFSA/ TAFSA, institutional & external scholarships, and student loans. Parents engage in an interactive activity to calculate the cost of a college education including tuition & books, room & board, travel, and personal expenses.



The Family Engagement Sessions are designed to equip parents with the knowledge, guidance, and tools they need to actively support and engage in their children's education.



The **College 1st Team** is formed by undergraduate and graduate college students along with industry professionals from diverse career backgrounds. They implement academic-enrichment activities, facilitate career exploration sessions, and engage with students in mentorship experiences.


